This new case session format is open to staff and their fellows. **Submissions must be made by the staff, and if accepted, presentations at the meeting must be delivered by the staff.**

Guidelines:

- Each presenter will have a maximum of 20 minutes per case, including discussion
- Focus on the core elements of the case itself, with little to no scientific data presentation
- Timing will be closely monitored
- Submissions should include images and a summary highlighting the major teaching point(s).

This is an opportunity for your institution to showcase challenging and educational cases, gain recognition and a prize for the 2 best cases!
